New in this Release

The following new features were released in Microsoft Teams Connector version 12.10.0.

- The connector has been updated following changes in the Microsoft Graph API.
- The connector can synchronize messages that were sent or received by a specific list of users. To specify the list of users, set the new configuration parameter `ExplicitUsers`.
- The connector can ingest recordings of calls. To do this, set `IndexCallRecordings=TRUE`.
- The connector indexes a single copy of each user chat message, and the document ACL includes all of the users permitted to read the message. Earlier versions of the connector indexed a separate copy of the message for each user included in the chat.
- If an error occurs when retrieving a message or attachment, the connector tries again on the next synchronize cycle. The parameter `MaxMessageRetries` has been added so that you can specify the maximum number of retries.
- Additional information is included in document metadata. For example, documents that represent attachments now include a field describing the MIME type of the file.
- The third-party libraries `libxml2` and `libxslt` have been updated, to versions 2.9.11 and 1.1.34 respectively.

Resolved Issues

The following issues were resolved in Microsoft Teams Connector version 12.10.0.

- When processing some attachments, the error "Failed to download attachment: Could not determine path in drive ..." could be seen in the logs.
- The `QueueInfo` action (with `QueueAction=GetStatus`) would return an error when the total number of actions exceeded 999.
